

Water supply upgrade is on the way

Engineer outlines what's in the pipeline for town water

A major upgrade of Narrabri's water supply will begin this year with completion expected in 2016.

Narrabri Shire's Director of Engineering Services Mr Andre Kompler has outlined the planned

sequence of works as the shire council utilises \$12.3 million in Resources for Regions funding to upgrade the

town water supply. The total cost of the project will be \$14.2 million.
